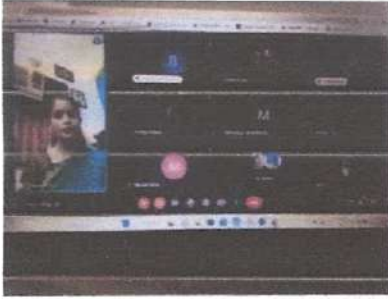

Our senior faculty Mrs Smita Ganatra, who is also an alumna of the college, organised a special session called Facing Interview.

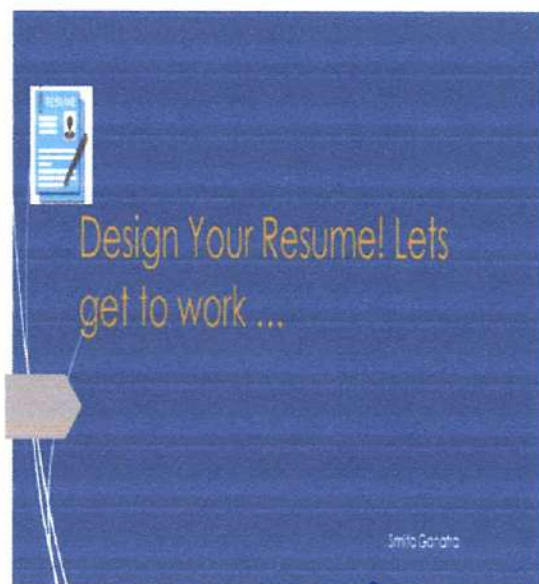

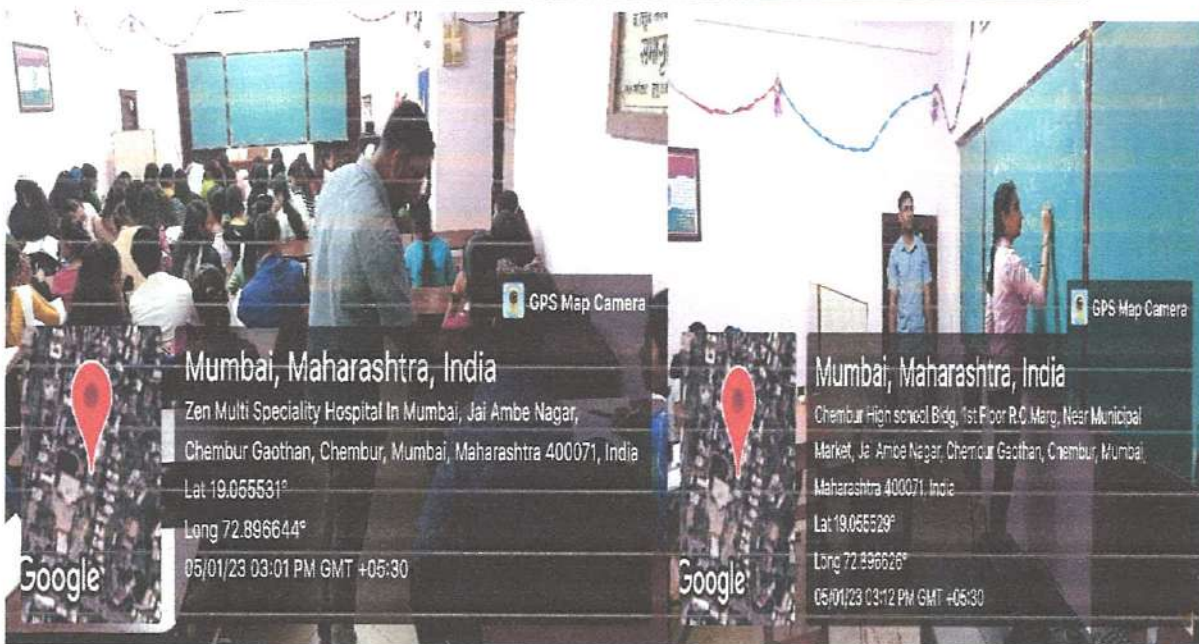


✓ **Training on 'Modi Script':**

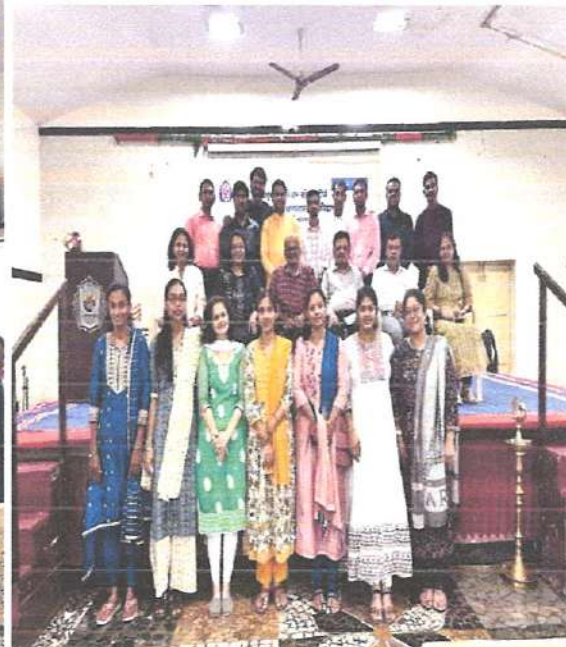


✓ **Discussion and planning for the growth and development of the Institution:**
