Report of the Nature trail: Maharashtra Nature Park, Dharavi

Today, A visit to Maharashtra Nature Park, Dharavi was organised for the student-teachers of CSSM, (Second Year B. Ed) along with our professors. The Park is located at a 10-minute walk from Sion Railway station. The Park, created over the biggest dumping ground in Mumbai stands an example as to what can be achieved through dedication and united efforts.


